She graduated from College of the Pacific in Stockton with a B.A. in Sociology and did graduate work at several Bay Area Universities.

Betsy's marriage to a Methodist minister produced three children. During that time she was involved in many community activities, including forming two human relation committees, but they left the ministry after leaders at their last church said she was not to be involved in inter-racial or Anti-war activities. The death of their 16 year old son a few months before her divorce left Betsy totally disillusioned with life.

Betsy then taught for 12 years before opening two Pre-Schools of her own, wrote articles on Race Relations for two major magazines, and edited a newsletter for an environmental organization. Then, while "playing around" with channeling, an entity claiming to be her son came through - which revitalized her life and led to writing this book.
